FAMILY BIBLE EXPLORATION

Share these points as you study John and Romans together as a family:



- **Where have you put Him?** Early on Sunday morning Mary Magdalene was at the tomb weeping because the tomb was empty. Inside the tomb were two angels who asked why Mary was crying. Mary confessed that she was crying because Jesus' body was gone and she didn't know where it had been taken. Mary turned to see a man whom she thought was the gardener, but it was really Jesus. Mary asked the man where Jesus was.
- **My name.** The power of hearing your name spoken is immense. Jesus spoke Mary's name and instantly she recognized Him as Jesus. Attempting to cling to Him, Jesus asked Mary to go tell the disciples He had been raised from the dead just as He said. Mary ran to tell the others what had happened and the disciples rejoiced.
- **Alone in a locked room.** The disciples had locked themselves in a room in fear of the Jews who may have wanted to retaliate since Jesus' body was no longer in the tomb. While in the locked room, Jesus appeared to those gathered. Jesus showed His hands and feet and encouraged the people. Later, when Thomas arrived, he was told by the others that Jesus had been raised. Thomas confessed his unbelief until he could see Jesus for himself. Eight days later, Jesus appeared again to the disciples, this time when Thomas was present. Thomas repented of his previous sin of doubt and sought Jesus.
- **Faith.** Jesus told Thomas that Thomas was blessed because he believed while seeing. However, Jesus said, those who believed without the benefit of seeing would be blessed as well. Faith in Jesus leads us to believe in Him as our Lord and Savior.
- **For the future.** Paul told the Romans that justification through Christ's death comes through faith in Jesus and only through Jesus. People who believe that Jesus is the Son of God and repent of their sin are declared to be righteous before Him. Faith in Jesus is the only path to God.
